#### Call to Order

Vice Chairman Morgan called the Board meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. A quorum was declared. Commissioner Smith joined by phone. Chairman Felts and Commissioner Shock were noted as being out on annual leave.

#### Approval of Minutes - May 11, 2023

Secretary Ryals moved for approval of the minutes. Commissioner Jones seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as presented.

A copy of the minutes was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Review of Population Reports**

Vice Chairman Morgan reviewed the population reports starting with the ADC report. He said all units with the exception of NWAWR are over 100% capacity. There is a jurisdictional count of 18,315.

Vice Chairman Morgan then reviewed the population report for DCC. The males are at 1,229, and the females are at 527 with a combined total of 1,756. The females are at 113.6% capacity, and the males are at 93.2% capacity with a total average of 98.5%. The grand total is 2,099.

Vice Chairman Morgan then reviewed the statewide field operations report. There are 22,811 individuals on parole and 32,949 on probation. There is a grand total of 66,973 individuals under supervision.

#### **Attorney General's Report**

Ms. Nga Mahfouz, Senior Assistant Attorney General, AG's Office, advised the Board that there has been no change since her last report. She said all pending cases are briefed and are waiting on the judges to make a ruling.

#### **Fiscal Report Update**

Ms. Christie Goldman, Business Operations Manager, APB, updated the Board on the Fiscal Report. Ms. Goldman reported that effective July 1, 2022, the Agency received funding of \$244,711 for Maintenance & Operations and Conference & Travel for fiscal year 2023. As of April 30, 2023, we've

expensed \$160,983.30 (65.79%) of the FY23 Maintenance & Operations and Conference & Travel Budget. At this time last year, the Board had exhausted 68.58% of the operating expense budget.

A copy of the fiscal report was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Hearing Judge's Report**

Vice Chairman Morgan updated the Board on revocation hearings conducted throughout the month of April 2023. There were 376 total revocations. There were 271 waivers signed, 37 individuals revoked at a hearing, and 68 administrative revocations.

A copy of the hearing judge report was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Agency Updates**

Ms. Goldman reminded the Board that eOMIS V5 will go live on Tuesday. She said all violation reports that are pending votes need to be done by the end of the week.

#### **Old Business**

There was nothing to report regarding old business.

#### **New Business**

There was nothing to report regarding new business.

#### **Files for Review**
