#### Call to Order

Chairman Felts called the Board meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. A quorum was declared. Commissioner Smith joined the meeting via telephone. Commissioner Shock was noted as being out on annual leave.

#### Approval of Minutes - October 12, 2023

Vice Chair Morgan moved for approval of the minutes. Commissioner Jones seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as presented.

A copy of the minutes was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Review of Population Reports**

Chairman Felts reviewed the population reports starting with the ADC report. He said almost every unit is over 100%. The overall total for males is 108.5%, and females is 107.5%. There is a total percentage of 108.4%. There is a total unit count of 16,177 including males and females. The total jurisdictional count is 18,536.

Chairman Felts then reviewed the population report for DCC. They are all over 100% with the exception of NW AR CCC. They are at 99.1%. They have a total of 1,885 with a capacity of 1,794. There is a total of 146 waiting to come in from the county jail backup.

Chairman Felts then reviewed the statewide field operations report. There are 22,790 individuals on parole and 33,707 on probation. There is a grand total of 68,002 individuals under supervision.

#### **Attorney General's Report**

Mr. Clayton Orr, Assistant Attorney General, AG's Office, went over the list of lawsuits that was provided to the Board. He said more cases have been moved to the dismissed column. Number 5's MTD was granted. Number 7 was dismissed. Number 10 has a MTD still hanging out there. Number 13's MTD was granted. Numbers 15 and 16 are new cases. Number 16 is a Claims Commission suit. He said there is one new APA case. It is number 8.

#### Fiscal Report Update

Ms. Christie Goldman, Business Operations Manager, APB, updated the Board on the Fiscal Report. Ms. Goldman reported that effective July 1, 2023, the Agency received funding of \$244,711 for

Maintenance & Operations and Conference & Travel for fiscal year 2024. As of September 30, 2023, we've expensed \$48,947.10 (20%) of the FY24 Maintenance & Operations and Conference & Travel Budget. At this time last year, the Board had exhausted 16.74% of the operating expense budget. A copy of the fiscal report was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Hearing Judge's Report**

Ms. Brooke D. Cummings, Executive Administrator, APB, updated the Board on revocation hearings conducted throughout the month of September 2023. There were 311 total revocations. There were 218 waivers, 27 individuals revoked at a hearing, and 66 administrative revocations.

A copy of the hearing judge report was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Agency Updates**

Ms. Cummings said there is a Revocation Hearing Judge position that is posted.
