POPULATION REPORT

RESEARCH/PLANNING

May 2020 Admissions and Releases – Admissions for May 2020 totaled 403 (377-males & 26-females) while releases totaled 751 (625-males & 126 females) for a decrease in-house of 348 inmates.

Inmate Population Growth/Projection – At the end of May 2020, the jurisdictional population for the Division of Correction totaled **16,694**, representing a decrease of **1,065** inmates since the first of January 2020. Calendar year 2020 average has seen an average decrease of **213** inmates per month, which is up from an average monthly decrease of **three** inmates per month during calendar year 2019.

Average County Jail Back-up – The backup in the County Jails averaged **581** inmates per day during the month of May 2020. Of the **581** average, short-term revocations accounted for **476** (418-males & 59-females) during the month.

INSTITUTIONS

PRISON RAPE ELIMINATION ACT (PREA)

PREA training for May was suspended due to COVID-19.

INMATE INSTITUTIONAL GRIEVANCES

Inmate Formal/Informal Grievances: During May 2020, a total of 2,073 formal grievances and 2,989 informal grievances were filed at various units.

Institutional Grievances Appeals: There was a total of 699 appeals of institutional grievances received in May 2020. Of those, 565 were acknowledged and 134 were rejected for various reasons. Of the total 434 appeals answered, 432 had no merit and two were found with merit.

FARM

May was a busy month at all farms across the state. The planting of corn and soybeans at the East Arkansas Regional Unit was completed. The Cummins Unit planted all rice and corn acres and almost half of the soybean crop. While fields at the Tucker Unit remained the wettest of the ADC farms, all of the corn crop was planted as well as more than 600 acres of soybeans and 380 acres of rice. Since ongoing wet conditions at Tucker prevented the scheduled rice planting for this year, a prevented planting claim will be filed on the crop insurance. The remaining rice acres will be shifted to soybeans.

Gardens around the state began growing better during the month and even yielded small amounts of produce.

The beef herd processed 489 calves at the Cummins Unit and about 400 at Wrightsville. The cattle market has been down due to COVID-19, so ideas for increasing sale value are being explored. One option being considered is changing the timing of calf sales for this year.

Milk and egg production have been remaining consistent and meeting the Department's needs. Pullets will be moved into the layer house the first week of July, which should result in an increase in production.

ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

DIVISION OF CORRECTION TRAINING - MAY 2020

BASIC TRAINING DIVISION -

Under the direction of instructor Kathleen Lowery, the 67 members of **BCOT Class 2020-E** completed on-the-job training (OJT) and officially graduated at their assigned units on May 8.

An awards ceremony was held for Instructor Ramone Woodall's **BCOT Class 2020-F** on May 15 at the Willis H. Sargent Training Academy. Bertha Freeman of the Delta Regional Unit received the Willis H. Sargent Award. The 52 members of the class wrapped up their training by completing two weeks of OJT at their assigned units before graduating on May 29.

IN-SERVICE DIVISION -

In-service training for the month of May was suspended due to continued COVID-19 precautions. All future training is suspended until further notice.

eCADEMY -

During May, 711 ADC employees completed a total of 11,591 hours of eCADEMY training. About 16% of ADC employees completed at least one course during that timeframe, averaging 2.57 hours per staff member.

HEALTH/CORRECTIONAL PROGRAMS

CHAPLAINCY SERVICES

All Facilities – During the month of May, unit chaplains continued to provide necessary services while volunteer access remained suspended due to COVID-19.

The Chaplaincy Division at all facilities made accommodations for Jumu'ah Prayer to be observed virtually over the video systems. While some facilities have the capability of delivering services onsite in real time, many require prerecorded services to be played at a time when the unit schedule permits.

The Islamic holy month of Ramadan observances concluded on May 23. Chaplains at each facility, along with unit administration, the Islamic population, and the Islamic Coordinator, worked to schedule the Eid al-Fitr celebration that follows Ramadan at an optimal time for each unit while practicing COVID-19 safety measures.

The average time on the waiting list from request is between one and two months for those stipulated.

The total on the waiting list, including those not currently within the identified timeframe, is 1,413 males – 1,086 of whom are low risk on the ARORA, and seven females – two of whom are low risk on the ARORA. There is one PREA inmate in the program at this time.

The average time on the waiting list from request is 21 days.

The total on the waiting list, including those not currently within the identified timeframe or ineligible due to class or housing status, is 2,772 males and 266 females; of these, 879 are low risk on the ARORA.

Substance Use Intervention Program: The Substance
Use Intervention Program had three admissions and 16
discharges for an end-of-month count of 18 for May. This
program is housed at the Varner Unit and is for inmates
found guilty of a disciplinary violation for drug use or drug
possession.

Ouachita River Correctional Unit (ORCU) Residential Program Unit (RPU): The RPU had six admissions and one discharge in May for an end-of-month count of 123.

McPherson Unit Mental Health Residential Program Unit (RPU): There were nine admissions and five discharges in May for an end-of-month count of 58.

Habilitation Program: The Habilitation Program at the Ouachita River Correctional Unit provided treatment services to 45 inmates during May. There were no admissions or discharges, which resulted in an end-of-month count of 45.

Anger Management Treatment: The Anger Management Treatment Program at the Cummins Unit provided treatment services to 29 inmates during May. There were zero admissions and nine discharges for an end-of-month count of 20.

The ADC continued taking measures addressing COVID-19 including:


