## DIVISION OF COMMUNITY CORRECTION VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

- Reentry Coach A volunteer who is matched with a Resident inside a Reentry/ Transitional Facility. The volunteer would meet with the Resident at a minimum of once a week for 45 minutes to help with goal setting, listen to their concerns/needs, and be a positive role model. (21 years of age or older)
- 2. Regular Volunteer A volunteer who donates their time in a Parole Office or facility to help staff and or Residents. This could include clerical, supervisory duties, faith-based, group sessions to name a few. (21 years of age or older)
- **3.** Intern A student enrolled at an accredited university who needs hours to complete their degree. Training provided by professionals at a Parole Office or facility. (18 years of age or older)

## **The Process**

- 1. Complete Volunteer Application
- 2. Pass Background Check
- 3. Mandatory 2-hour training
