SEXUAL ASSAULT IS A CRIME! Tell Someone Now.

If you have been assaulted, don't hide. You are a victim and you have the right to be heard and to be safe.

The Arkansas Department of Corrections (DOC) has zero tolerance for all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment of offenders by staff, contractors, volunteers or other offenders.

The DOC accepts and investigates all reports of sexual abuse or sexual harassment in confinement facilities, including third party and anonymous reports.

WAYS TO REPORT:

- 1. Tell any DOC staff member or volunteer.
- 2. Call the DOC Prison Rape EliminationAct (PREA) Report Line:*870267 or *9123
- 3. File a grievance.
- 4. Have a family member report for you by calling:(501) 683-5391

The DOC PREA Report Line and the Arkansas State Police PREA Report Line are for reporting PREA issues only. These report lines are for inmates to report PREA-related issues by leaving a message.

Messages are routinely checked, but the report lines are not live monitored. The report lines are not for emergency use. Repeat calls, non-PREA related calls, and false reporting will result in disciplinary action.
