- Tracy Dowell attended the Career Education & Workforce Development Board Meeting on December 14th.
- ACSD (Academic and CTE) began Christmas Break on December 17th. Classes will resume on January 3rd.
- Bill Glover attended the ARESC Board meeting on December 13th.

ACSD principals and teachers spent most of December testing students. Pre/GED testing increases in December. Quarterly WRAT (Wide Range Aptitude Test) testing was also completed. CEA requires quarterly testing of students using a national recognized test. After WRAT testing is complete, the testing instrument is scored and the results are entered into eOMIS.

School staff also completed on-unit technology Professional Development.

Landscape Construction and Design instructor, Donald Kendrick, received the following message on 12/27/2021 from Shawn Morrow. Morrow completed CTE on 11/3/2021 and released later that month.
