

# DOC FACILITY RISK LEVELS FAQ



Each week, the Department of Corrections works with contracted medical provider Wellpath to evaluate the COVID-19 risk level at each DOC facility. Information about current risk levels are posted outside each facility's entrance.

Risk level is calculated using a weighted point system assigned to three factors:

## 1) CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL RISK LEVEL FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE FACILITY IS LOCATED:

- CDC level low = 1 point
- CDC level medium = 2 points
- CDC level high = 3 points

## 2) INTAKE STATUS

- Facilities used for intake of inmates/residents receive 1 point

## 3) POSITIVITY RATE

Based on number of confirmed COVID-19 cases at each facility during the past 7 days:

- 0% to 2% = 2 points
- 3% to 4% = 4 points
- 5% and greater = 6 points

**High** | 8 and higher overall score

**Medium** | 5-7 overall score

**Low** | 0-4 overall score
