# SECRETARY'S OFFICE COMMUNICATIONS:

In June, the Communications Team helped get the word out positive programming, including the new computer lab at the Omega Supervision Sanction Center and the Veterans Outreach Program at the Barbara Ester Unit. We also used National Selfie Day as an opportunity to build staff morale and show the general public how the DOC Family can have fun while we're working hard.

Also in June, we welcomed the U.S. Marshals Eastern Arkansas Fugitive Task Force as new neighbors at DOC Headquarters in North Little Rock. The Comms shop used social media and DOC Connect to highlight the important work being accomplished and staff achievements at the Ouachita River, Randall L. Williams, McPherson, Pine Bluff, Wrightsville, Hawkins, Ester, Tucker and Delta Regional units, the Northwest Arkansas Work Release Center, the East Central and Central Arkansas Community Correction Centers and Areas 1, 4, 6, 9, 10 and 11.

The team honored graduates of Parole/ Probation Officer Class 2-22 and ADC's Basic Correctional Officer Training Classes 2022-H and 2022-G. We also helped welcome new cadets to the Residential Services Basic Training Academy Class 2-22.

# **COMMUNICATIONS**, continued:

We featured 13 community service projects completed by regional maintenance crews. Our recruitment efforts in June included promoting seven job fairs and 21 career opportunities.

The Communications Team fielded 99 constituent emails, 352 constituent calls and responded to 13 FOIA requests. During the month of June, 1,776 ADC and 60 DCC visitation appointments occurred. Also in June, six Correctional Leaders Association surveys were completed.

## **PROCUREMENT UPDATE:**

In June 2022, Purchase Orders and Contracts in excess of \$10,000 amounted to \$7,695,232.26, broken down as follows:

## **BENEFITS** -

In June, a total of 62 FMLA requests were processed for the **Division of Correction**. Of those, 62 were approved. A total of ten catastrophic leave requests were received. Of those, seven were approved, two were denied and one is pending.

A total of 18 FMLA requests were processed for the **Division of Community Correction** in June. Of those, 17 were approved and one was denied. A total of nine catastrophic leave requests were received with five approved, one denied and three pending.

# PHYSICAL ASSESSMENTS -

A total of 211 **Division of Correction** incumbent personnel and applicants were assessed in the month of June. Of those, 71 incumbent personnel passed their physical assessments. Three did not pass nor rescheduled. The number of applicants who successfully completed their physical assessments totaled 134. Three did not pass and did not reschedule.

#### **EMPLOYMENT -**

In June, 1,945 applications were received through the state jobs website for the Department of Corrections.

# **VIDEO COURT HEARINGS -**

IT assisted staff as needed for a total of 183 inmate video meetings during the month utilizing the following platforms:

**VPN** – DIS has provided access to AnyConnect VPN. The server team is testing with DIS to make sure the security groups created for this project are given the appropriate access to the permissions they require.

**MERAKI** – The process continues of removing all Meraki installations on DOC laptops, reclaiming those licenses, and moving all laptops to Microsoft Intune for management. Currently, there are 362 laptops remaining in Meraki, with 129 devices having been removed in June.

**SCHOOL DISTRICT ICEV PROJECT** – IT continues to work on deploying thin clients at Varner. It was determined that and additional five thin clients are needed at Varner and five at Randall L Williams.

**LAW LIBRARY** – An issue was encountered with Westlaw thin clients getting stuck on the

Westlaw splash page. Westlaw made a change to their site which requires cookies to be accepted by the browser. In the initial coding of the Westlaw browser, cookies were not a requirement; therefore, a method was not coded for the browser to parse cookies or for the user to accept them. This issue was resolved by configuring the chrome browser in application mode, which allowed the connection to accept cookies by the browser.

**MOBILE DEVICE MANAGEMENT** – The iOS 15.5 software version was pushed to 934 devices out of a total 1145 iOS devices. All iOS devices in Meraki are now on iOS 15. This is a major accomplishment as all of our devices have never been on the current major version of iOS before release of the next major version. Thanks goes to the Desktop Support team and staff for their assistance in this accomplishment and keeping the agency's devices secure.

# **RESEARCH AND PLANNING/ APPLICATION DEVELOPMENT:**

#### **TRAINING:**

DOC Research and Planning Staff conducted five eOMIS user tests for new DCC staff during June. Additionally, staff provided training on several topics: eOMIS Basics, Incident Reports and eOMIS Security Training. Bryan Rodgers and Dylan Self continued the Applied Data Analytics course with the Coleridge Initiative, beginning work on their group projects. Robin White and Bryan Rodgers attended the Corrections Technology Association's annual summit, where Robin presented on the topic of Arkansas' advances in the use of biometric technology for facility access and visitation.

#### DATA GATHERING AND DISTRIBUTION:

During the month, the Research and Planning Team completed and submitted its work on 11 projects and ad-hoc data requests.

#### eOMIS DEVELOPMENT:

Staff worked with Marquis to complete 26 eOMIS updates during the month of June. This month, two large projects were promoted to production: the new administrative transfer form and the large-scale Arkansas Correctional School District updates. Both projects are the culmination of several months of

planning and meeting with the end users within the Department to ensure that the result meets the needs of both the users and the Department as a whole. Robin White provided training to both divisions' records teams on the new form and process prior to implementation, and work on building a recurring report of the administrative transfer data should conclude in July. Restrictive housing updates will begin user testing in early July as well.

# QUALITY IMPROVEMENT AND PROGRAM EVALUATION (QI/PE):

QI/PE staff spoke to Governor Hutchinson about their projects and experiences working in a correctional agency. QI/PE staff also began their project on drug court recidivism rates. Finally, the staff and the Research and Planning Administrator finished the first portion of the Reduction of Sexual Victimization and Sexual Offender Female Treatment program assessments.
