## CTE Update

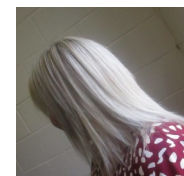
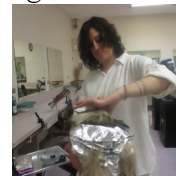
Varner CTE students are running fiber optic cable to the CTE building. After the thin clients are installed, students will be able to test online for NCCER certification.



Varner’s welding class built and installed ladder racks for the Cummins fire truck.

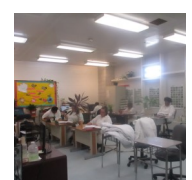
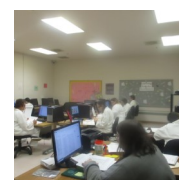
