#### Call to Order

Chairman Felts called the Board meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. A quorum was declared. Commissioner Smith and Vice Chair Ryals were noted as being out on annual leave.

#### Approval of Minutes - October 13, 2022

Secretary Morgan moved for approval of the minutes. Commissioner McCastlain seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as presented.

A copy of the minutes was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Review of Population Reports**

Chairman Felts reviewed the population reports starting with the ADC report. All units are over 100% capacity. They have an in count of 17,348 and a jurisdictional count of 17,486. There are 106 out to court, 10 out to other hospitals, 21 out to the ORCU hospital, and 287 in the county jails as 309's. There are 92 females and 1,612 males in the county jail backup. They have a combined total of 1,704.

Chairman Felts then reviewed the population report for DCC. They have a total of 99.5% males and 109.7% females. They have a combined total of 102.4%.

Chairman Felts then reviewed the statewide field operations report. There are 23,246 individuals on parole, 22 out on Act 539, 8 at Boot Camp, and 33,294 on probation. There is a grand total of 67,283 individuals under supervision.

#### **Attorney General's Report**

Mr. Joe West, Assistant Attorney General, Attorney General's Office, reported to the Board that there has been no change. There are 9 cases still pending.

#### **Fiscal Report Update**

Chairman Felts updated the Board on the Fiscal Report. He reported that effective July 1, 2022, the Agency received funding of \$244,711 for Maintenance & Operations and Conference & Travel for fiscal year 2023. As of September 30, 2022, we've expensed \$40,961.45 (16.74%) of the FY23 Maintenance & Operations and Conference & Travel Budget. At this time last year, the Board had exhausted 16.41% of the operating expense budget.

A copy of the fiscal report was included in each board member's packet for review.

#### **Hearing Judge's Report**

Chairman Felts updated the Board on revocation hearings conducted throughout the month of September 2022. There were 320 laws and technical violations, 117 laws only violations, and 28 technical only violations. There were 465 total violations.

A copy of the hearing judge report was included in each board member's packet for review.
