The cost of GED testing is going up July 1st. The price will increase from \$4 for each of the four tests (RLA, Math, Social Studies, & Science), to \$10 for each of the tests. For a tester who passes each of the GED tests on the first try, the price will increase from \$16 to \$40. Free retests are decreasing from two to one.

Ready testing will remain \$6 per subject.
