# Arkansas Correctional School District

Arkansas Correctional School District recently added 2 new heavy equipment modules, feller buncher and log loader, to the Heavy Equipment Operator program. An additional base was also purchased. Training was provided to the staff on November 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. In the near future, the two new modules will be a part of a new forestry program at Varner.



Three practice roofs, one flat and two pitched, are being constructed at Varner for the new Commercial and Residential Roofing program.



Arkansas Correctional School District staff are now providing ServSafe Food Handler training to kitchen workers. 231 kitchen workers at ORCU received the training during the month of November. Participants receive a certificate after completing the training and school district staff then uploads the certificate into eOMIS.
