COMMUNITY SUPERVISION AREA HIGHLIGHTS:

AREA 1

CSA Foreman, DEA TFO, assisted in significant Drug Bust. 453 grams of meth was recovered. DEA personnel developed information that John Bass (Active Probationer-PID #: 0097303) was involved in the sale and distribution of Methamphetamines in the Northwest Arkansas area. During the investigation, it was confirmed that Bass would be receiving a pound of Methamphetamines in the mail being delivered to his listed address (16688 Carefree Lane, Lowell, Arkansas 72745) by the United States Postal Service on May 9, 2025. Plans were developed to conduct surveillance around the address and await the package to arrive. Once the package arrived, and Bass took possession of the package, law enforcement would converge on the property and take Bass into custody/intercept the package. DEA was in communication with USPS and notification would be sent once the package had arrived. At approximately 1400 Hours, surveillance vehicles took positions around the perimeter of the property. At approximately 1500 Hours, members observed the USPS vehicle heading towards the target address and confirmation was received the package was about to be delivered. Once the package was delivered to the mailbox, Bass was observed to exit the residence and pick up the package. We simultaneously converged on the property and took Bass into custody without incident. Package was seized for a search warrant and a compliance check search of the property was completed. Bass was later released pending further investigation. On May 12, 2025, a search warrant approved and executed on the package and yielded 453 Grams of Methamphetamines.

AREA 2

On May 22, a multiagency coordination was conducted by Arkansas Division of Community Correction, Marion County Sheriff's Department, Arkansas State Police, and 14th Judicial Drug Task Force to execute a search warrant at 105 S Pauline Street Summit, Arkansas 72677. When officers arrived at the residence, Community Supervision Agent David Beaty and Deputy Castle approached the rear of the home while the remaining officers approached the front. Agent Beaty observed two males flee the back door of the home who were apprehended with the assistance of Officer Castle's K9. The males were identified as Torie Ply, with an active Abscond Warrant issued by the Arkansas Post-Prison Transfer Board, and James Paxton who had multiple outstanding warrants. As officers approached the front of the home, three females were

observed with Torie Ply's father. Lakayn Rogers was arrested for possessing fentanyl pills and April Byrd was arrested for outstanding warrants. A search of the home resulted in the discovery of Methamphetamine, Fentanyl, Marijuana and numerous items of drug paraphernalia. Charges are pending for Tori Ply, who was taken into custody by Marion County Sheriff's Department.

AREA 3

AREA 10

5/21/2025: A home visit was conducted at Steven Byrd's listed address by CSA Tiffani Childers and CSA Jennifer Starkey. Agents conducted a search of the residence and located a plate with marijuana and a grinder in the bathroom. They also located a black box on the side table in the living room. It contained a scale and a silver cap that contained suspected meth residue. They also located a painted, dark green jar that contained a crystal-like rock that was suspected to meth. CSA Childers contacted the HSCSO and officer Morrow reported to the residence. He took the drugs as evidence and released Byrd pending charges.

AREA 11

At approximately 3:00pm on 5/16/2025 me, Agent Parker, and Agent Graydon conducted a home visit at 3705 S. Olive St, due to the offender had stolen a Toyota Avalon from his boss Austin at American Tire (pictures was taken scanned into EOMIS), Upon arriving I (Officer Williams) knocked at the door, and notice the lock to the front door was missing, after another knock at the door, the offender yelled who is it. I stated Officer Williams from Probation and Parole, the offender opens the front door and appeared to be high, I (Officer Williams) asked Damont is there anyone else in the home, and he stated NO. I advised him to turn around to be place in handcuffs, so we can search his resident. The offender was very combative, and I ask him was he high and was there any drugs or weapons in the home, and he proceeded to lie @ first until we found 3.04 grams of Methamphetamine and a pipe in his room (pictures scanned into EOMIS). Agent Parker had called for assistance from PBPD due to the fact we had found the drug in his home @ approximately 3:30pm Detective J. Johnson showed up and stated what do we need. We explain to him the situation and he stated his Captain (Howard) had only told him to come and

assist not to arrest or charge the offender. He then called Cpt. Howard again to tell him what we had told him, and he said again he only told him to assist and not to arrest or charge him, he went on to say his Cpt. said we need to do the charging since it's our parolee. Agent Parker and I advised Dectitive Johnson when did they start doing that b/c when we used to find drugs, and guns we will call you guys so y'all can come out and charge them or give them a citation. I then proceeded to ask the offender where the car was, he had taken again he became very combative stating that's his car. I ask him where the title and the bill of sells saying this your car. He couldn't give me the proof only could show me he paid \$500 down on the car, and Austin proceeded to show he have given his money back to him when he got fired early in the week. The car was found hidden in his garage (pictures scanned into EOMIS) and given back to the owner Austin. We let the offender go and we left without incident. Offender Damont Williams was given instruction to report to the office on Monday 5/19/2025 @ 9am.Dectitive J. Johnson stated to me that the report will be ready, and he will email it to me on Monday 5/19/2025.

TREATMENT:

2,311 probationers and parolees were served in the general Substance Use Disorder Treatment programs. Another 1,446 participants were served in the Drug Court Treatment programs, bringing the total served to 3,757 for the month.

REENTRY PROGRAM:

REENTRY FACILITIES:


As of May 31, ACC had six licensed Reentry Facilities with 180 total residents in Phases I-IV of the Reentry program. Since the program began, there have been 3,363 individuals who have successfully completed and graduated from the program. During the month, five (5) residents completed WAGE. six (6) residents completed CRC with nine (9) enrolling. A total of thirteen (13) Reentry Facility residents received their driver's license, thirteen (13) received an ID card, twenty-eight (28) received their Social Security Cards and twenty-two (22) received birth certificates.

REENTRY PROGRAM CONTINUED:

REENTRY OFFICERS:

In May, 153 Reentry residents was reported to be employed and 21 residents were reported to be ineligible for employment at this time. Reentry Officers reported six (6) education referrals, which resulted in enrollments.

Reentry Officers conducted 130 reentry facility office visits, 103 Phase IV office visits, 15 Phase IV home visits and 39 preparole plan verifications. Reentry Officers made 29 community contacts within their assigned area during the month and conducted 48 office visits in their area. There was three (3) Good Grid classes conducted across the state with twelve (12) referrals and in attendance. Five job fairs were held with 10 referrals.



TRANSITIONAL HOUSING:

There are 16 licensed vendor facilities with 553 beds (436 DOC funded) in the facilities. Within the transitional facilities, there are 218 residents who have obtained full-time employment. In May, 256 residents who previously received their GED or high school diploma.

During the month, there were 38 registered sex offenders living in transitional facilities.

A total of 14 residents received their driver's license, 81 received an ID card, 89 received their Social Security card and 15 received birth certificates. Through new community partnerships, three (3) were enrolled in GED.

A total of 46 residents graduated from the Transitional Housing program, 19 absconded and 14 were dismissed.




