COMMUNITY SUPERVISION AREA HIGHLIGHTS:

AREA 1

Area 1 Washington CO SO Staff conducted SO Residence verifcation with members of Washington CO Sheriffs Office. AREA 2

On April 3, a home visit was conducted in Horseshoe Bend by Community Supervision Agents Cody Bruyette and Hunter Boles along with Investigator Sean Tomlinson and Deputy Nick Taylor of the Izard County Sheriff's Department. Multiple supervised individuals were present at the residence at the time of the visit. A compliance search of the residence resulted in the discovery of multiple items of drug paraphernalia as well as substances believed to be methamphetamine and THC. Those present were taken into

custody by the Izard County Sheriff's Department.

AREA 3

On April 3, 2025, Lawrence County Drug Court held a Drug Court Graduation Ceremony, recognizing the successful completion of the drug court program and probation period by 5 participants. Judge Rob Ratton provided a bbq meal as well as a celebration with cupcakes.

AREA 4

On April 10, 2025, Area 4 Community Supervision Agents Ashley Stuart and Thomas "Ross" Spurlock along with SOAP Aftercare Agent Michelle Earnhart attended the local Special Olympics games. The Agents along with Law Enforcement Officers from the Craighead County Sheriff's Department, Brookland Police Department, Harrisburg Police Department, Arkansas State Police, and the Jonesboro Police Department cheered the athletes on as they participated in various events. After events were completed, the Law Enforcement Officers got to present event winners with their respective medals and ribbons.

AREA 7/8

On 4/8/25, ISP received information that offender Tyler Cart was involved in possible narcotics distribution at 6204 Allwood in North Little Rock. Cart had an appointment on 4/8/25 at 10:00am. Cart left the probation office at a high rate of speed and was stopped in his driveway by NLRPD. Cart was detained and ISP agents along with NLRPD narcotics made entry and cleared the home. A search of the upstairs bedroom on the right was found to belong to Cart. Pill bottles, and a Pulaski County inmate ID with Carts name was found. Under the mattress on the bed was a Draco located. Weapon was cleared for officer safety. Agents located a vacuum sealed bag with marijuana and a digital scale inside the leg of a pair of coveralls hanging up. NLRPD took control of the scene, evidence, and Cart.

AREA 9

On 04/01/2025, Agent Tigue and Agent Miners extradited Charles Matthew ADC#163393 from Bowie County, Texas. On 04/01/2025 - 04/02/2025 - Agent Scoggins and Agent O'Malley conducted a flight extradition on Melvin White ADC#155734 from Salt Lake County Utah to Miller County Jail where he was held over night for Area 4 -Crittenden County. On 04/02/2025 - Cheyenne Brown ADC 718363 was transported from Miller County Jail to Phoenix Recovery Center in Little Rock, AR.

04/17/2025 - Tonsorial Arts Barber College set up hair/beard cutting station for offenders that cannot afford to pay for the service. Tonsorial Arts lead barber is a former ACC offender that turned his life around.

AREA HIGHLIGHTS, continued:

AREA 10

04/29/2025: On April 29, 2025, CSA Tiffani Childers and CSA Jennifer Starkey conducted a home visit investigating an intrastate transfer on Crystal Speer PID#0361128 and confiscated 7.83 grams of methamphetamine and 8.7 grams (0.02 pounds) of marijuana. The offender is pending charges with the Hot Springs County sheriff's office.

AREA 11

On 4-1-25 Offender Kenneth Ard PID 0165006 arrived for office visit as scheduled to See officer Eastman for his regularly scheduled office visit. Officer Eastman requested the assistance of Agents Parker and Johnson in conducting a home verification/inspection of offender Ards residence at 8211 Bice Road in Pine Bluff. Upon arrival, a female named Dorthy Irwin opened the door stating Ard does not live at the approved address. She pointed down the road in the direction of a storage shed belonging to another address, 8111 Bice Dr, stating he has been living down there. Ard was asked if he had been staying there, he stated yes. A male by the name Mike Bice, the owner of the residence confirmed Ard had been sleeping in the storage shed. Both Agents Johnson and Parker searched the storage shed and a black 2016 Ford Fusion Ard stated belonged to him. Agent Parker found a pipe used to smoke meth next to the bed in the storage shed. Ard was asked if it belonged to him. He stated yes. Agents Johnson and Parker, Officer Eastman and Ard went back to the approved residence, 8211 Bice Road and conducted a home search after Dorothy Irwin confirmed offender Ard did stay at the residence occasionally. In the shop located on the property Agent Johnson located a bag of methamphetamine in a pack of cigarettes in a pair of pants on a chair. Inside of a black zip pouch Agent Parker located two syringes one of which was contained a liquid believed to be heroin and a small vile with crystal methamphetamine in it and two glass methamphetamine pipes. Inside the residence Agent Parker found underneath the coffee table in front of the couch Agent Parker located two methamphetamine pipes, a small amount of marijuana in a paper towel, Pom cigarillos and digital scales with crystal methamphetamine on it. Agent Parker opened a door and spotted a .22 rifle in the corner of the room with a scope and a .25 handgun on a nightstand by the bed. On a chest of drawers he noticed a jar with a bag of marijuana inside of it. Mecca was called and Investigators Carter and Kendell arrived on scene. Upon investigation Investigators collected the evidence. Offender Ard was charged with misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia and the resident owner Mike Bice was charged with possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia.

TREATMENT:

2,450 probationers and parolees were served in the general Substance Use Disorder Treatment programs. Another 1,456 participants were served in the Drug Court Treatment programs, bringing the total served to 3,906 for the month.

REENTRY PROGRAM:

REENTRY FACILITIES:

As of April 30, ACC had six licensed Reentry Facilities with 176 total residents in Phases I-IV of the Reentry program. Since the program began, there have been 3,363 individuals who have successfully completed and graduated from the program. During the month, five (5) residents completed WAGE with five (5) additional enrolling. Four(4) residents completed CRC with four (4) enrolling. A total of twenty-one (21) Reentry Facility residents received their driver's license, twenty-one (21) received an ID card, twenty (20) received their Social Security Cards and eight (8) received birth certificates.

REENTRY PROGRAM CONTINUED: REENTRY OFFICERS:

In April, 113 Reentry residents was reported to be employed and 21 residents were reported to be ineligible for employment at this time. Reentry Officers reported nine (9) education referrals, which resulted in enrollments.

Reentry Officers conducted 172 reentry facility office visits, 146 Phase IV office visits, 20 Phase IV home visits and 49 preparole plan verifications. Reentry Officers made 57 community contacts within their assigned area during the month and conducted 47 office visits in their area. There was three (3) Good Grid classes conducted across the state with twentyseven (27) referrals and in attendance. Job fairs were held with 8 referrals, and 246 in attendance. 7 department of Workforce Services classes were held with 185 in attendance.



TRANSITIONAL HOUSING:

There are 16 licensed vendor facilities with 553 beds (384 DOC funded) in the facilities. Within the transitional facilities, there are 182 residents who have obtained full-time employment. In April, 238 residents who previously received their GED or high school diploma.

During the month, there were 26 registered sex offenders living in transitional facilities.

A total of 25 residents received their driver's license, 105 received an ID card, 105 received their Social Security card and 19 received birth certificates. Through new community partnerships, three (3) were enrolled in GED.

A total of 54 residents graduated from the Transitional Housing program, 30 absconded and 19 were dismissed.


