COMMUNITY SUPERVISION AREA HIGHLIGHTS:

AREA 2

On January 31, an Community Supervision agent conducted a Home Visit at the residence of an offender under supervison. An Ash Flat Police Department Officer was also present to speak to the offender regarding a theft that had occurred in Ash Flat. When officers arrived, they located two offenders at the residence, both of which are on active supervision. Officers conducted a search of the residence locating four (4) Zip Lock baggies that contained a green leafy substance believed to be Marijuana in the bedroom. There were also two smaller plastic baggies which contained numerous rolling papers, a grinder, and three smoking devices in the dresser. On top of the dresser were two other smoking devices and a set of digital scales. Items were confiscated, placed in a paper bag, labeled and transported to the evidence locker in the Fulton Co. Sheriff's Dept. The investigation and evidence will be turned over to the Fulton Co. Sheriff's Office and 16th Judicial Drug Task Force.

AREA 3

On January 23, an agent and White County Detectives conducted an office visit with an offender. White County Detectives received information and evidence supporting possible offenses of distributing and possessing or viewing material depicting sexual conduct involving a child. During the office visit, the offender admitted to receiving and viewing child pornography. At this time, ISP officers, agents and White County Detectives conducted a home visit/ search warrant on the offenders listed address. Officers and Deputies made contact with the offenders mother and secured the residence. All evidence was collected by White County Detectives. The offender was taken

into custody and transported to the White County Detention Center for the Offenses of distributing and possessing or viewing material depicting sexual conduct involving a child, possession of drug paraphernalia, and possession of a schedule 1 or 2 less than 2 grams of cocaine/methamphetamines.

AREA 4

On January 23, an offender reported to the Paragould office and discovered she had been driven to the office by another offender on active supervison. The officer conducted a search of the other offender and his vehicle and found a meth pipe, digital scales, a machete, and a large can of pepper spray in addition to meth was found on his person. A search was conducted of the offenders purse where the officer located morphine pills to which she then admitted to having drugs at her house. A home visit was then conducted and Officers found 9 grams of meth, 6 grams of marijuana, scales and baggies. The offender was charged with possession of controlled substance with purpose to deliver. The other offender was charged with possession of controlled substance and possession of paraphernalia and also subsequently had his parole revoked for Laws and Weapons.

AREA 11

On January 2, an offender arrived for office visit as scheduled and was placed

in hand restraints and leg irons to conduct a home search. Agents transported the offender to his listed residence which was a duplex. He initially stated he lived in the one on left. When Agents made entrance it was filled with trash and it was obvious that no one was living in it. Agents found two marijuana pipes. The agents then questioned the offender who admitted he actually lived in the one on the right. Upon making entrance, Agents made contact with another person who confirmed the offender lived there on the couch and was seeing her daughter. A search was conducted of the home. During the search, an agent found 10 Marijuana pipes and digital scales and called the Pine Bluff Police Department. PBPD examined the evidence and determined no charges would be filed. The offender was instructed to destroy the pipes in front of agents to which he complied and destroyed the pipes and also poured out three beers found in the refrigerator.

On January 31, an ISP Agent, SRT and Pine Bluff Police Department conducted a home visit at the residence of an offender on active supervision. Numerous firearms and marijuana were found at the residence. The offender is a suspect in a murder of another active parolee. He has been charged with Capital Murder, Possession of a Firearm by Certain Persons, and abuse of a corpse.

TREATMENT:

PROGRAM SUMMARY

2,462 probationers and parolees were served in the general Substance Use Disorder Treatment programs. Another 1,600 participants were served in the Drug Court Treatment programs, bringing the total served to 4,062 for the month.

A total of 143 residents have agreed to participate in Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) since the program started in July 2018 with a total of four admitted into the program this month. A total of 155 have completed the program.

In addition, the MAT supervisor has been coordinating with River Valley Medical and Wellness to provide mobile recovery services to offices in rural areas.

Partnerships are in effect with 80 community providers to continue MAT upon release from an ACC center.

In January, there were 27 active participants in the Telehealth program implemented in January 2023.


Treatment supervisors reported combined 221 hours of direct clinical supervision with Treatment staff in 29 Community Correction locations.

REENTRY PROGRAM:

REENTRY FACILITIES:

As of January 31, ACC had five licensed Reentry Facilities with 163 total residents in Phases I-IV of the Reentry program. Since the program began, a total of 3,071 individuals have successfully completed and

graduated from the program. There was a total of 23 reentry graduates during the month.



During the

month, 31 new residents were transferred into the Reentry program, six residents started the Career Readiness Certificate program and two residents completed the program. A total of 26 Reentry Facility residents received their driver's license, nine received an ID card, 13 received their Social Security card and 12 received birth certificates.

REENTRY OFFICERS:

In January, 103 Reentry residents were reported to be employed and 27 residents were reported to be ineligible for employment at this time. Reentry Officers reported one education referral, which resulted in

enrollments.

Reentry Officers conducted 126 reentry facility office visits, 123 Phase IV office visits, 34 Phase IV home visits and 45 pre-parole plan verifications. Reentry Officers made 39 community contacts within their assigned area during the month and conducted 82 office visits in their area.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING:

There are 18 licensed vendor facilities with 589 beds (478 ACC-funded) in the facilities. Within the transitional facilities, there are 232 residents who have obtained full-time employment.


In January, 249 residents who previously received their GED or high school diploma.

During the month, there were 45 registered sex offenders living in transitional facilities.

A total of 22 residents received their driver's license,

100 received an ID card, 112 received their Social Security card and 23 received birth certificates.

A total of 55 residents graduated from the Transitional Housing program, 32 absconded and 21 were dismissed.


