POPULATION REPORT

RESEARCH/PLANNING

December 2023 Admissions and Releases – Admissions for December 2023 totaled **508** (431-males and 77-females) while releases totaled **395** (330-males and 65 females) for a net increase in-house of 113 inmates.

Inmate Population Growth/Projection – At the end of December 2023, the jurisdictional population for the Division of Correction totaled **18,503**, representing an increase of **855** inmates since the first of January 2023. At reporting time, calendar year 2023 has seen an average rate of **71** inmates per month, which is up from an average monthly increase of **52** inmates per month during calendar year 2022.

Average County Jail Backup – The backup in the county jails averaged 1,663 inmates per day during the month of December 2023, which was down from the per-day average of 1,844 inmates during the month of November 2023. Of the 1,663 average, short-term revocations accounted for 254 (211 males and 43 females) during the month.

House Bill 1530/Restrictive Housing (RH) - October 31, 2023 through December 31, 2023 -

- There was a 3.4% decrease in overall RH assignments during the fourth quarter of 2023 compared to the third quarter of 2023.
- There was a 1.6% increase in the number of major disciplinaries this quarter.
- There was an increase in those aged 21 or younger and those with an SMI diagnosis who were held in RH, as compared to the third quarter. However, there was a slight decrease in the number of inmates assigned to protective custody and those aged 55 or older.
- There was one suicide during the quarter and a slight decrease in the number of suicide attempts compared to the previous quarter.
- This quarter, there were two deaths of those who were housed in RH, which is a decrease compared to the third quarter.

INSTITUTIONS

INMATE INSTITUTIONAL GRIEVANCES

Inmate Formal/Informal Grievances: During December, a total of 897 formal grievances and 1,332 informal grievances were filed at various units.

Institutional Grievances Appeals: There was a total of 347 appeals of institutional grievances received in December. Of those, 256 were acknowledged and 91 were rejected for various reasons. Of the total, 168 appeals answered, 165 had no merit and three had merit.

FARM DIVISION

December was a slower month around the agriculture division. All farms continued to do field work and drainage work as they could.

Garden production was good with lots of greens being brought into kitchens.

The beef herds started feeding hay in some areas after being able to let the cows graze stockpiled grass from the summer almost an extra month this year.

Milk and eggs are steady with a new flock of pullets moving in February.

Row Crop crews spent time doing preventative maintenance on equipment and repairing what was needed for the upcoming year.

CHAPLAINCY SERVICES AND COMMUNITY SPEAKING EVENTS

All Facilities -

The Chaplaincy Division worked throughout the final quarter of 2023 to organize Christmas gift bag distributions at all units. Thanks to the hard work and generosity of statewide volunteers, the partnership of many churches and ministry groups, and the leadership of our staff chaplains, gift bags were provided for all ADC inmates.

Cummins Unit -

Four volunteers sang Christmas carols in the east hall barracks on December 21 while gift bags were being distributed.

East Arkansas Regional Unit -

A five-day revival took place from December 4 through December 8 with a total of 351 inmates attending throughout the event.

Hawkins Unit -

The Community Bible Study group gave a Christmas party to 14 APAL students December 18 to celebrate finishing the study phase of the Book of John. The party was catered by Chick-Fil-A.

Maximum Security Unit -

Chaplain Bourgeois spoke on volunteer and job opportunities in ADC at the 100 Families Pulaski County Youth Violence Coalition on December 7.

There are 829 males on the waiting list for RSVP and zero females on the waiting list for SOFT who are within five years of their TE date. Of those, eight inmates are mandated by the Parole Board.

The average time on the waiting list from request is between one and two months for those stipulated.

*The total on the waiting list, including those not currently within the identified timeframe, is 1,636 males and zero females. Of these, 829 are eligible and 807 are ineligible for the program. There are zero PREA inmate in the program at this time.

For TC/SATP/SURS, there are 2,811 males and 372 females on the waiting list who are within five years of their release date. Of those, 60 are mandated by the Parole Board.

The average time on the waiting list from request is 16 days.

*The total on the waiting list, including those not currently within the identified timeframe, is 3,946 males and 453 females. Of these, 3,242 are eligible and 1,156 are ineligible for the program.

*Ineligibility is due to being in restrictive housing, having class IV status, or receiving a major disciplinary within the last 60 days.

Ouachita River Correctional Unit (ORCU) Residential Program Unit (RPU):

The RPU had six admissions and one discharge in December for an end-of-month count of 121.

McPherson Unit Mental Health Residential Program Unit (RPU):

There were three admissions and three discharges in December for an end-of-month count of 40.

Habilitation Program:

The Habilitation Program at the Ouachita River Correctional Unit provided treatment services to 43 inmates in December. There were zero admissions and zero discharges, which resulted in an end-of-month count of 43.

Anger Management Treatment:

The Anger Management Treatment Program at the Cummins Unit did not provide treatment services to any inmates in December. There were no admissions or discharges, for an end-of-month count of zero.

Suicide:

There were 117 suicidal threats in December. There were five attempts, one of which resulted in death.
