POPULATION REPORT

RESEARCH/PLANNING

August 2023 Admissions and Releases – Admissions for August 2023 totaled **578** (485-males and 93-females) while releases totaled **467** (384-males and 83 females) for a net increase in-house of 111 inmates.

Inmate Population Growth/Projection – At the end of August 2023, the jurisdictional population for the Division of Correction totaled 18,375, representing an increase of 727 inmates since the first of January 2023. At reporting time, calendar year 2023 has seen an average rate of 91 inmates per month, which is up from an average monthly increase of 52 inmates per month during calendar year 2022.

Average County Jail Backup – The backup in the county jails averaged **2,147** inmates per day during the month of August 2023, which was up from the per-day average of **2,131** inmates during the month of June 2023. Of the **2,147** average, short-term revocations accounted for **363** (327 males and 36 females) during the month.

INSTITUTIONS

INMATE INSTITUTIONAL GRIEVANCES

Inmate Formal/Informal Grievances: During August, a total of 1,101 formal grievances and 1,885 informal grievances were filed at various units.

Institutional Grievances Appeals: There was a total of 469 appeals of institutional grievances received in August. Of those, 354 were acknowledged and 115 were rejected for various reasons. Of the total, 379 appeals answered, 372 had no merit and seven had merit.

FARM DIVISION

August weather stayed hot and dry, however it made for perfect harvest weather. Cummins Unit started harvesting rice and corn, Tucker Unit started harvesting rice and East Arkansas Regional Unit started harvesting corn. The rice and corn crops are yielding more than last years totals. All farms are still irrigating the soybean crop and harvest will begin mid-September.

The grain market pricing is down and we are planning to store all that we can until the pricing increases.

While the August weather made for perfect harvest, the heat took a toll on livestock. Beef cattle mostly spent time in the shade or water and the dairy cows and chicken came off feed causing production of milk and eggs to slow. At this time, the cattle market is very high so the Cummins and Wrightsville Units are making plans to keep the calves through the winter and plant what forage is needed to keep them fed in hopes of an upside potential in the calf market next spring.

Next years crop planning is underway with wheat and oat seed bids going out in September. Soybean, corn and rice bids will go out in October or shortly after.
