<b>SUBJECT: FURLOUGH PROGRAM</b>			

**I. AUTHORITY.** The Board of Corrections is vested with the authority to promulgate this rule by Arkansas law sections 12-27-105, 16-93-1203 and 16-93-1205.

**II. POLICY.** The Board of Corrections supports the implementation of furlough programs to authorize temporary release of a resident from a community correction center.

**III. GUIDANCE.**

**A.** Arkansas Community Correction must establish and maintain procedures and criteria that provide for the furlough of a resident when a critical illness/injury and/or death occurs to a member of the resident's immediate family or when a resident has been approved for community transition activities away from the Community Correction Center (CCC). Procedures must include rules/conditions of resident release on furlough and requirements for sponsors to include supervision, transportation, and timely return of the furloughed resident.

**B.** Furlough criteria must be made accessible to residents and explained during orientation.
