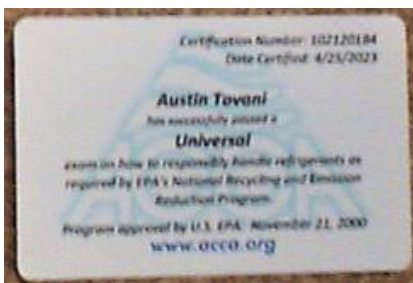


Above: Mr. Perry's Building and Grounds Maintenance class at EARU built two porches for the free line housing.
